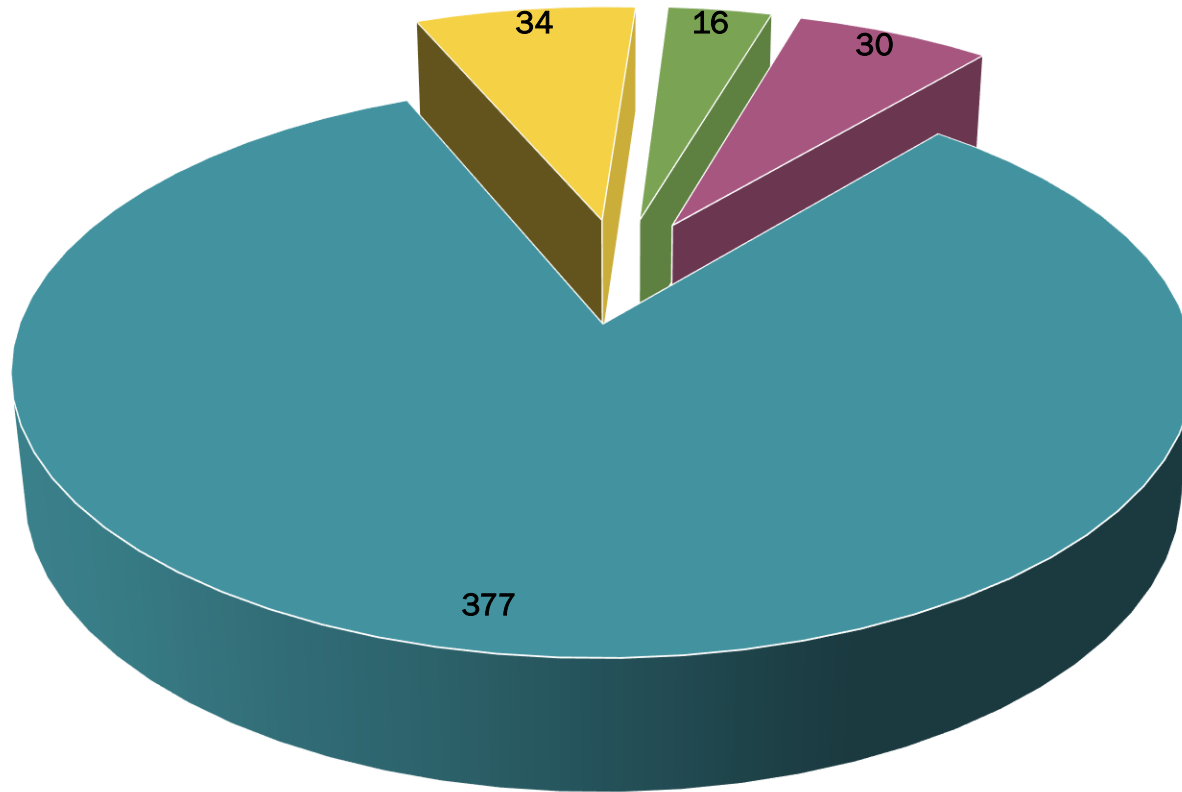

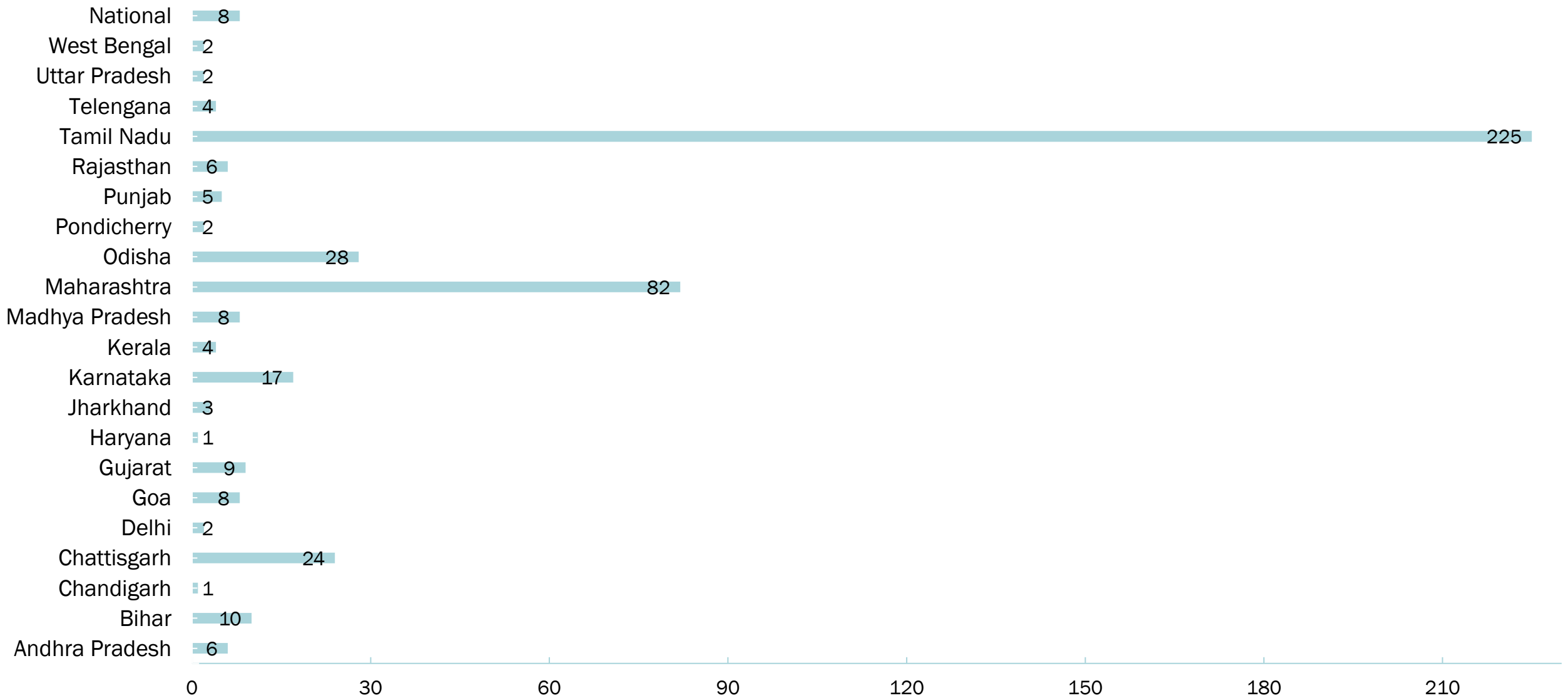
Number of online webinars

Total number of webinars - 457

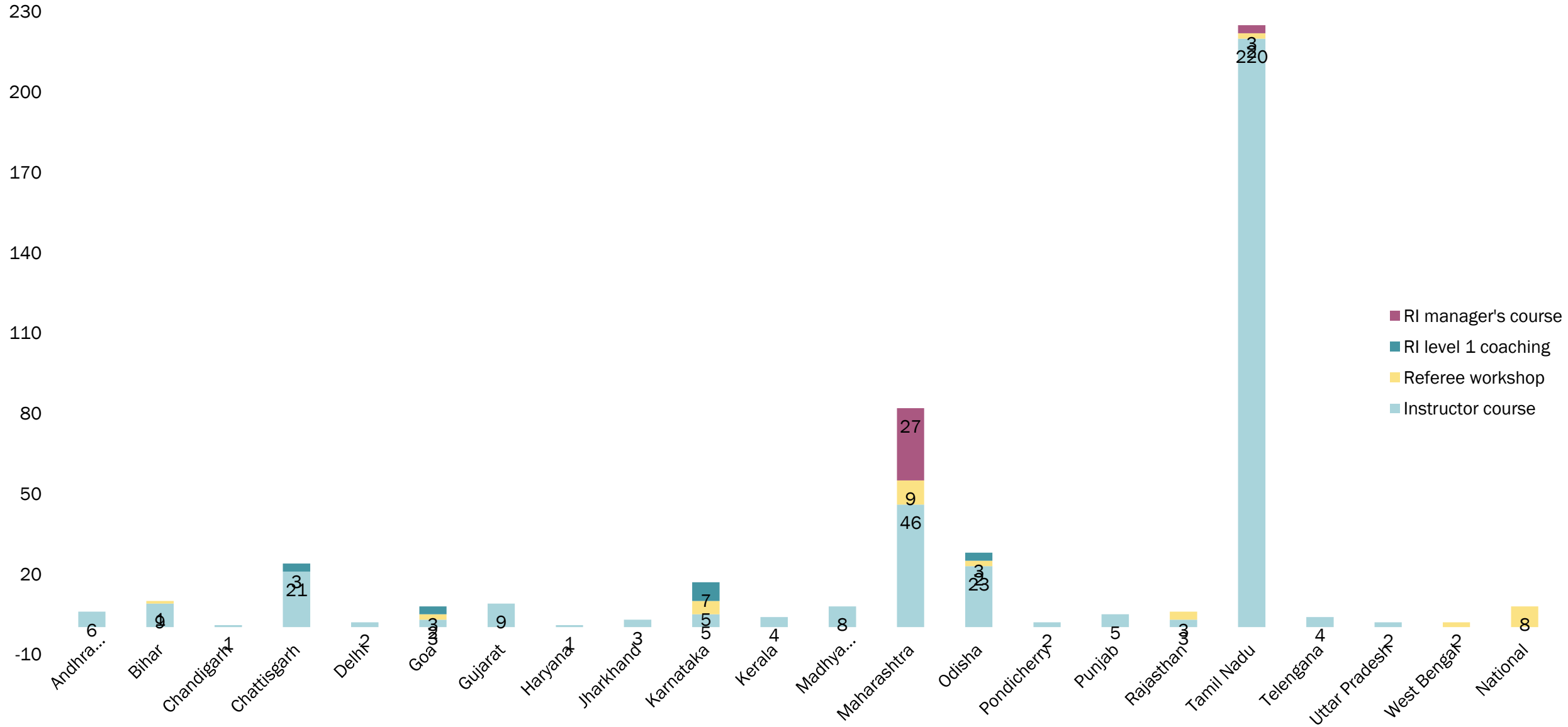

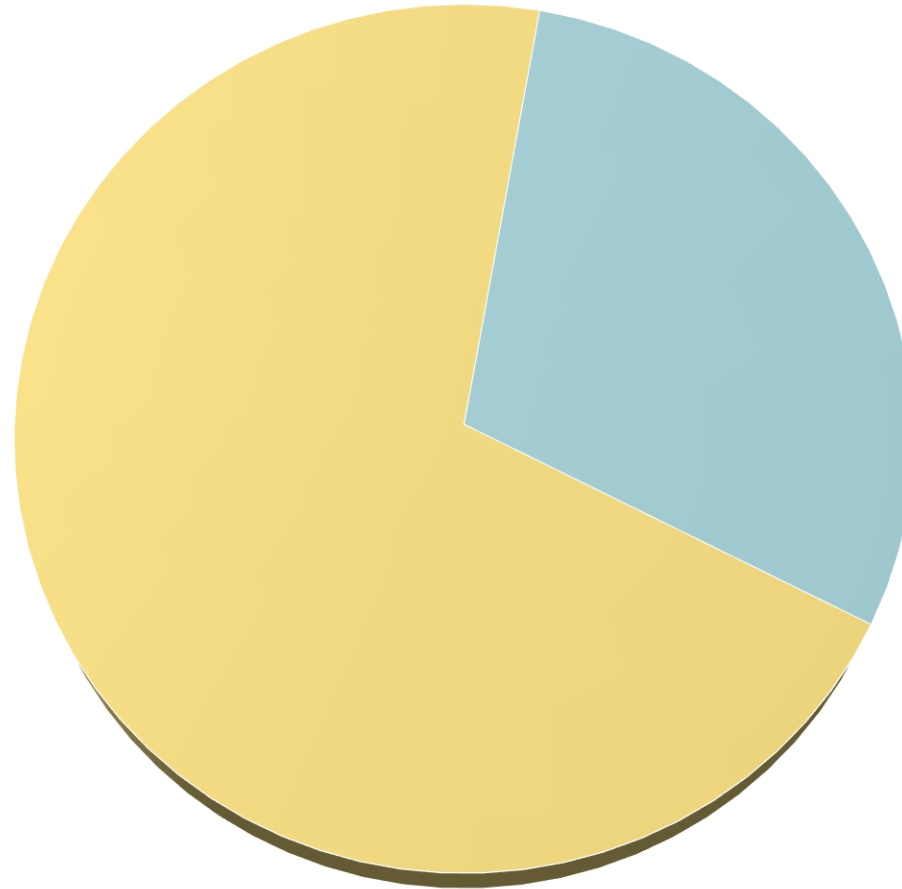
State wise distribution



State wise courses



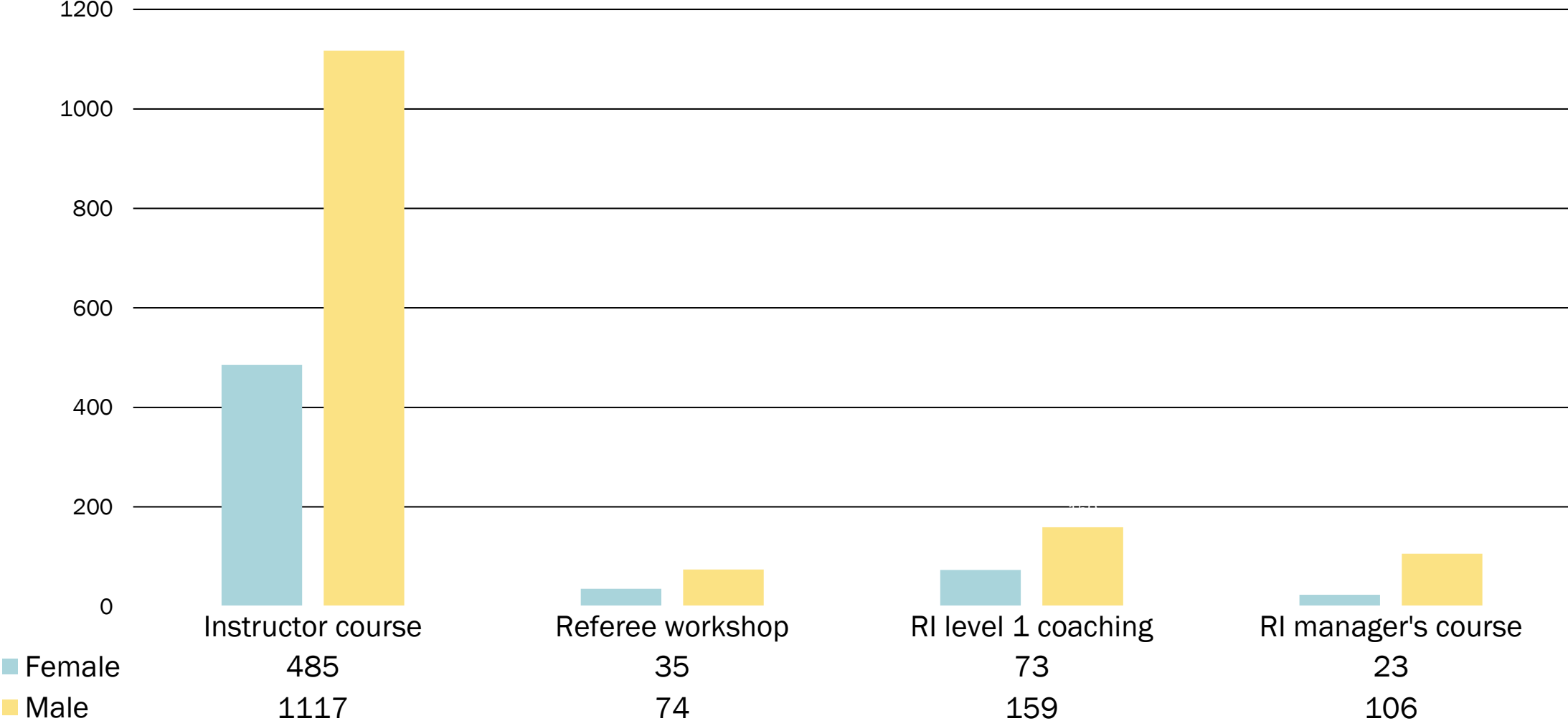
Participant Ratio



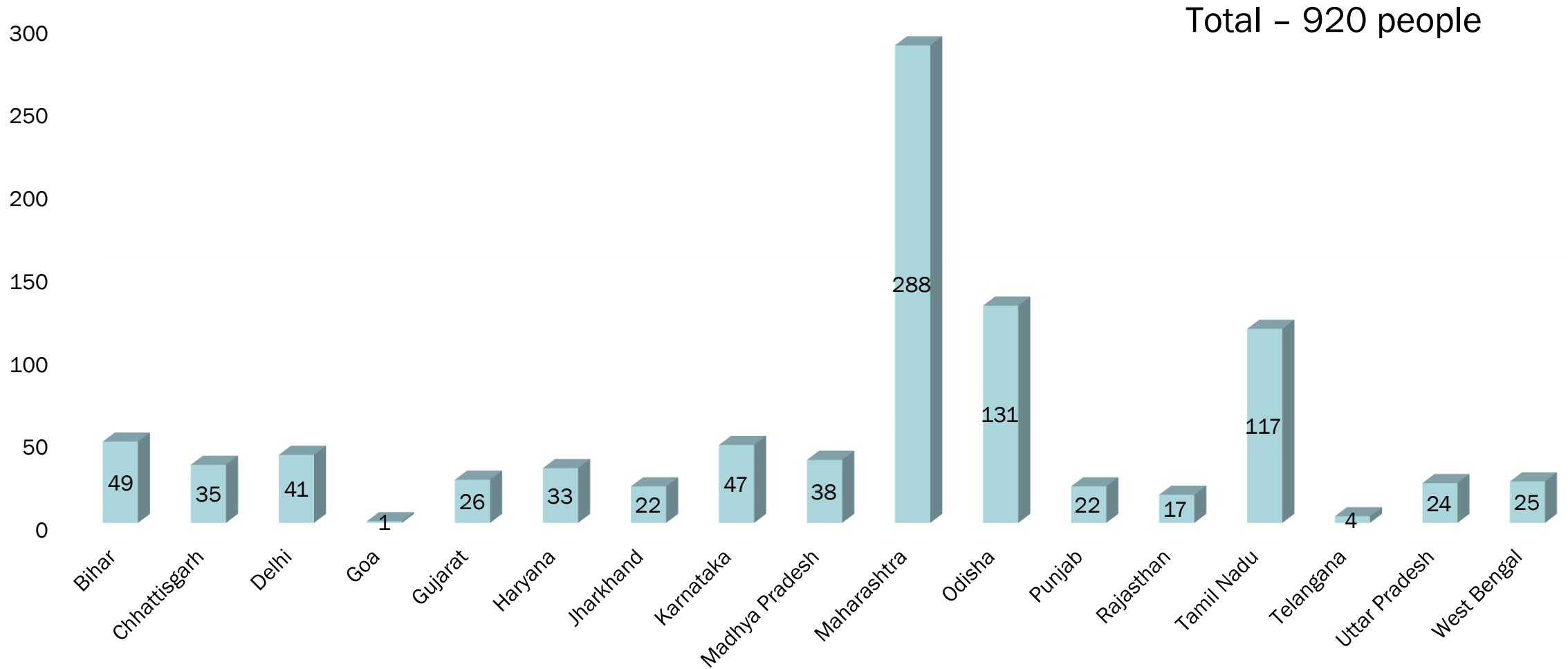
Total number of participants – 2072

Engagement from Webinars

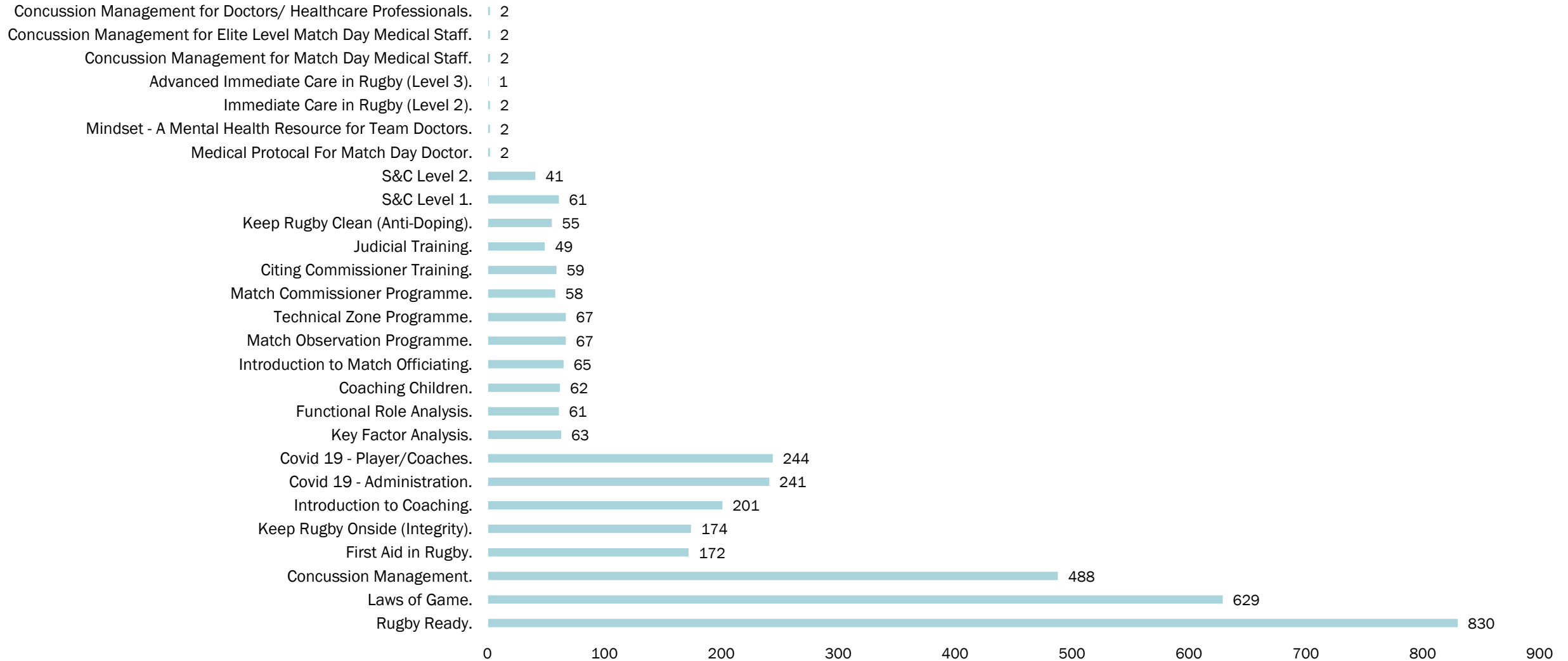


WR Passport – online exam Database
